This accession consists of 8.2 meters of textual records, 754 photographs (black and white prints and negatives), 23 audio reels, 2 audiocassettes, 95 postcards and 29 maps. The textual records consists of correspondence, Porritt's notes, accounting records, banking records, other business records including a Traders Fur Record Book, records pertaining to the Northwest Territories Legislative Council (consisting primarily of copies), memorabilia, Jock McMeekan's records, a few annual reports and newsletters, some posters and ephemera. In particular, the records document Porritt's occupational and political activities, his personal interests and his relationships with many friends and family members. The photographs, taken and collected by Porritt, cover a wide variety of subjects and dates. The photographs were sorted according to a several categories including: communities such as Yellowknife, Hay River, Fort Resolution, Fort Smith, Fort Rae, Fort Norman, Snowdrift, Pine Point and Arctic Red River; family and friends; native people; aircraft and pilots; boats and ships; politics; prospecting and mining; logging; trapping, fishing and hunting; railways; and trucking.

INTRODUCTION

Robert Forritt, 1905-1984, owned, managed, and otherwise participated in businesses in Fort Resolution and Hay River, and served as Member of the Legislative Council from 1954-1960 and 1963-1967. The Robert Forritt Papers document his occupational and political activities, his personal interests and his relationships with many friends and family members.

This collection of correspondence, handwritten notes, business records, political records, Council records, records of local organizations, memorabilia, maps, plans, sound recordings and photographs spans a period from the 1920s to Forritt's death in 1984. They appear to show one entrepreneur's entire network of operation, revealing social, economic, and political connections between individuals, companies and government in this formative period in the region, particularly in Fort Resolution and Hay River.

In 1986 some 70 linear metres of records, which included newspapers and government publications, were moved to the Northwest Territories Archives. Although the records had survived a flood and subsequent repacking, virtually no original order was been discernible. Thus preparation for appraisal and arrangement required several stages of sorting. While arrangement has been completed, where applicable, to the file folder level, description has only been achieved to the series level. The photograph series has been listed to the item level and is complemented by a full set of indexes.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Robert "Bobby" Porritt was born in 1905 in Leeds, England. He came to Canada with his family in 1912, and they moved to a homestead farm near Jarvie, Alberta in 1915. He counted his northern residency from 1927, when he apparently first came to the Northwest Territories as a carpenter, spending a couple of years on projects in Fort Smith, Fort Simpson and Fort Resolution. He remained in Fort Resolution to become the first Canadian Airways agent [1927?]. During his years in Fort Resolution he also worked as postmaster [1930?] and spent seven years in the fur trade with Northern Traders. In 1938 he started the Fort Resolution Lumber Co., which supplied lumber around the lake, particularly for Yellowknife buildings such as the Old Stope Hotel. Forritt spent some time in Yellowknife, coordinating lumber orders, and claims to have built the first Yellowknife school in 1939. The lumber business led to a water freight business, Robert Porritt Transportation, which appears to have been based in Yellowknife [1944-1949?]. In 1949 Forritt moved to Hay River to set up a general store, a fur trading business and an insurance agency. During this period he often had difficulty paying his suppliers who occasionally threatened him with legal action. He set up the short-lived Great Slave Industries in 1969, planning to build a marina in Hay River, and was also involved in the revival of the sawmill in Fort Resolution during the same year. He continued to trade furs until the end of his life in 1984.

Active politically for many years, Porritt ran for the Yellowknife Town Council as early as 1945. He lost his first bid for the Northwest Territories Legislative Council in 1951, but was successful in 1954, 1957 and 1964, spending almost ten years on Council (1954-1960, 1964-1967). As a member of the Council he was particularly interested in issues such as transportation, native welfare, health care, fisheries, trapping, education, postal service, and the Hay River economy. He was also active in local politics and local organizations, was appointed to the Hay River Board of Trustees in 1950, and spent at least seven years on the board of trustees, municipal and town councils of Hay River. He was president of the Hay River Chamber of Commerce, chair of the Lands and Parks Committee, and a member of the local Health Board, the Hospital Committee, the Public Works Committee, and the Kiwanis Club.

Forritt travelled frequently to Ottawa and elsewhere as a member of the Council, and particularly to Edmonton, where he had many friends. For more detailed notes on his family, friends and travel as evident through the correspondence, see Appendix I. For other detailed biographical information see the Series Description.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Robert Porritt Papers consist of correspondence, his notes, accounting records, banking records, other business records, records pertaining to the Northwest Territories Legislative Council (consisting primarily of copies), memorabilia, Jock McMeekan's records, a few annual reports and newsletters, some posters and ephemera, newspaper clippings, maps and plans, currently unidentified sound recordings, and photographs. Arrangement of series is by type of record, with the correspondence arranged in somewhat more detail than most other series.

The correspondence, in particular, is an excellent record of the economic, social and political aspects of life in Hay River from the late 1940s to the early 1980s. Offering an apparently comprehensive view of the community – as Forritt appears to have maintained intense personal contacts with the majority of the people in the area – the correspondence, business records, and political records may provide one of the, at present, few sources for the detailed study of a northern community during this period. There is considerable correspondence with native people in the area, many of them hunters and trappers who had become friends of Forritt. Also well documented, through the correspondence and the business records of the Fort Resolution Lumber Co., is the Fort Resolution community during the 1930s.

Accounting records were voluminous, fragmented, incomplete, and many of them revealing very little. Careful appraisal has therefore been necessary although retention, approximately 30% of what was received, has been generous. Although many of these records will not provide more than a peripheral indication of business operations some examples of Porritt's accounting practices will be evident in the SAMPLE CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS FILES series.

Since Porritt was Member of the Legislative Council for Mackenzie South the Papers include correspondence with various other members of Council (e.g. Commissioner Ben G. Sivertz and John Goodall) and members of parliament. These letters, which can be located in the INCOMING CORRESPONDENCE series, include discussion about political and bureaucratic issues facing Council before the move of the territorial government to Yellowknife in 1967.

Unusually active in local organizations, Porritt's papers include his correspondence on behalf of these. His interest in all aspects of his community, the north, and the world in general, are revealed in the magazines, ephemera, posters and many other types of items he collected. Northern records have been retained while others, such as issues of the Edmonton Journal, and large quantities of travel brochures and travel mementos from all over Canada and Europe, have not. Significant numbers of new issues of Northwest Territories newspapers, as well as territorial government publications, have been transferred to our holdings of these records.

The photographs taken and collected by Porritt cover a wide variety of subjects and dates. Photographs of family members, friends, business colleagues, communities and special interests such as aircraft and marine transportation dominate this series. The photographs have various levels of identification from none at all to complete details of people, places and dates. Many of the unidentified images have been returned to the family, however a number have been retained due to their special subject matter. This is particularly true in the case of photographs of aircraft and marine transportation. As with the textual materials the photographs of this collection lacked any sense of original order. As a result, an order was imposed by the Archives Technician in consultation with the Archivist. The photographs were sorted according to a several categories including: communities; family and friends; native people; aircraft and pilots; boats and ships; politics; prospecting and mining; logging; trapping, fishing and hunting; railways; and trucking. The most efficient access to the photographs is via the indexes.

SERIES DESCRIPTION

OUTGOING CORRESPONDENCE (1929-1982). 54 cm. Boxes 1 to 2.

This series contains handwritten carbon copies and drafts, typed copies of letters, and outgoing telegrams. Most letters concern business or financial matters and are addressed to suppliers, creditors, lawyers, banks, government agencies, business associates, and customers, while those concerning Legislative Council business appear to be drafts prepared for typing. Also included are drafts of personal notes, perhaps never sent. See also the HANDWRITTEN NOTES series for similar notes. Arrangement is chronological; 14 cm. of undated correspondence is unarranged.

INCOMING CORRESPONDENCE (Cca. 1928-19831). 1.8 m. Boxes 3 to 9.

Incoming letters and telegrams document most aspects of Porritt's business, political and personal life. These are addressed to Porritt as well as to his companies, particularly Fort Resolution Lumber Co. and Hay River Supplies, and to him as a representative of local organizations such as the Hay River Chamber of Commerce. Correspondents include Canadian Airways Limited (concerning his early work as an airways agent), fur dealers in Edmonton, territorial government offices, constituents when he was a Member of the Legislative Council, fellow Councillors as well as Commissioners, federal government offices, particularly the Indian Agency, and a wide variety of local, territorial, Canadian and foreign contacts, both personal and work related. For copies of correspondence not directed or copied to him but acquired as part of Council business see the MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL RECORDS series. Arrangement is alphabetical by correspondent's name; 20 cm. of correspondence showing incomplete or illegible names is unarranged.

CHRISTMAS CARDS (Eca. 1930-1984]). 26 cm. Boxes 9 to 10.

Robert Porritt saved many Christmas cards so primarily those containing messages have been retained. Most cards are undated but the series spans much of Porritt's life and includes an assortment of cards from the 1930s and 1940s. There is a selection of cards from the Northwest Territories, cards from well-known northern personalities, including government officials, and a number of cards containing photographs. Also included in this series are birthday, Easter, and Valentine cards with messages, as well as a few cards signed by Porritt, probably intended to be sent or which were returned by the postal service. For letters which had been included with cards see the INCOMING CORRESPONDENCE series. Unarranged.

MISCELLANEOUS SUBJECT FILES (1939-1978). 27 cm. Box 10.

This series documents Forritt's municipal interests, business involvements and personal files. He retained minutes, by-laws, reports, and notices for a number of local associations and societies such as the Northwest Territories Prospectors' Association, Hay River Citizens' Committee and the Vale Island Ratepayers Association. He also retained records from the municipalities of Fort Smith and Hay River, Hay River Hospital Board, and Hay River Chamber of Commerce (which includes a visitors' book and membership lists). The business files relate to Porritt's involvements with Great Slave Industries, Fort Resolution

Lumber Co-operative, Vale Island Post Office, attempts to develop a Hay River Marina, and the specifications for Yellowknife's first school, built in 1939. Included are records belonging to Forritt family members, including correspondence, notes on family history and on Porritt's own life, as well as some correspondence addressed to business associates. Unarranged.

HANDWRITTEN NOTES (Cca. 1935-1980]). 38 cm. Boxes 11 to 12.

The large volume of handwritten notes seem to indicate that Porritt frequently kept paper and pencil at hand and made a note of ideas as he thought of them. Included here are miscellaneous notes on a wide variety of topics, drafts of speeches and letters, cue cards for speeches, notes made at Northwest Territories Council meetings, notes and lists related to elections, notes taken by him or others at community organization meetings (often undated), handwritten and mimeographed poems, notes on people and area history taken from a variety of sources, notes on his family history, handwritten itineraries, lists of names and addresses, a few notes pertaining to his business activities, diary notes, and a few notes written by others. Those notes of a political nature, approximately 21 cm., document employment, health and land issues concerning natives, transportation (e.g. railway routes, a road to Fort Resolution, Mackenzie highway bridge), trapping, postal rates, tourism, small business and municipal concerns. Unarranged though politically related notes are indicated as such.

NOTES TO PORRITT ([ca. 1949-1965]). 7 cm. Box 13.

Most of the notes are scraps of paper bearing handwritten requests to Porritt from his customers for groceries, supplies, or small loans, 'on account'. The notes are signed and although only a few are dated, they were likely all written during the Hay River Supplies period. While many of the notes are little more than grocery lists, they do reveal something of Porritt's relationship with his customers, his method of business, and a little of the customers themselves, many of whom were native. Forritt appears to have retained the notes as part of his accounting system, using them to write up either his counter sales checks recording individual sales, or his statements to the customers. Brief notes to Porritt on miscellaneous topics have also been included in this series. Unarranged.

NOTEBOOKS (Eca. 1930-1984]). 35 cm. Boxes 13 to 14.

Porritt's notebooks document many of the same issues as the series HANDWRITTEN NOTES. They contain notes of a political nature, notes on other people and events, notes on Porritt's family history and his own life. The notes are generally sporadic; each notebook contains writing on a number of different topics, but often only a few pages are filled. Porritt apparently considered writing a book on northern 'personalities' and events, or on his own life, and made notes accordingly. He wrote notes and stories on people such as Gilbert Labine, C.B. Dawson, and Dr. C. Rourget, and notes on life in the north in general. Some of the notebooks contain brief 'diaries' of Porritt and possibly of other people. There are diary notes of 1933-1934 that may or may not have been written by Porritt and a brief journal that may belong to his mother, Caroline Porritt. The notebooks also contain lists of trappers, of Royal Canadian Mounted Police personnel, and of Christmas and Valentine cards received and sent. Only a few of the notes are dated. Unarranged.

FINANCIAL AND LEGAL MISCELLANY (1929-1984). 22 cm. Box 15.

This series contains a wide variety of financial and legal miscellany concerning issues such as taxes, insurance, permits, licenses, certificates, investments, real estate, Crown assets purchases and legal matters. The municipal, territorial and federal tax records date from 1948 to 1982 and consist primarily of notices, assessments and receipts. Included are records of Caroline Porritt and other family members concerning Porritt's property in Alberta. Insurance policies, both commercial and personal, date from 1933 and include lists of Porritt's household belongings. The legal documents consist of items such as summonses, agreements, statements of claim, bills of sale, contracts, and suppense. This series also provides information on compensation for the 1963 flood in Hay River, mineral claims transferred to Porritt and the receivership of Great Slave Wood Products (Porritt was a creditor). Unarranged.

BANKING RECORDS (1932-1984). 52 cm. Boxes 15 to 17.

There are no records in this series for 1934-1938, 1940-1941 and 1978, and while the bulk of the records date between 1950 and 1973, they are incomplete even for these years. The series consists of Porritt's cancelled cheques and bank statements. These records reflect both his business and personal transactions without a clear separation between the two, although usually more than one account is represented for a given period. For the banking records of the Fort Resolution Lumber Co., which are far better represented, see the FORT RESOLUTION LUMBER CO. RECORDS series. Arrangement is chronological by year. Corresponding statements and cheques are filed together while loose statements are interfiled.

JOURNALS AND LEDGERS (1933-1983). 52 cm. Boxes 17 to 19.

The journals and ledgers are mainly of the accounting records for Hay River Supplies between 1949-1959, although some of his other business activities such as Fort Resolution Lumber Co., his role as postmaster at Fort Resolution, cabin rentals, and fur trading are represented. The books are primarily customer accounts, but there are also books listing expenses, daily cash, native accounts/rations, and payroll. While many of the journals and ledgers are numbered, Porritt's system of accounting is not clear and the records are not complete. He often removed pages of accounts and many of these can be found in the series SAMPLE CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS FILES and CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS. The books have been arranged in chronological order when dates could be determined.

RECEIPT BOOKS (1934-1982). 21 cm. Box 19.

There are no books from 1937-1948 and 1973-1981. The receipt books dated 1934-1936 record, for example, payment of sawmill wages. The later series reflect the business transactions of Hay River Supplies as well as fur trading and cabin rentals. They include receipts for accounts receivable, but also receipts for cash loaned by Porritt. Arranged chronologically.

SAMPLE STATEMENTS AND INVOICES (1939-1979). 2 cm. Box 19.

This series represents a small sampling of the statements, invoices, way bills and packing slips issued to Hay River Supplies or Robert Porritt. Included are examples from the major supply and service companies such as Scott Fruit Co., Horne & Pitfield Ltd., Pike & Co., Byers Transport and J.H. Ashdown Hardware Co. Unarranged.

FORT RESOLUTION LUMBER CO. RECORDS (1938-1947). 20 cm. Boxes 19 to 20.

Porritt was a director and shareholder of the Fort Resolution Lumber Co. This series contains almost all the records pertaining to this company, including those that relate to other series including BANKING RECORDS, JOURNALS AND LEDGERS, and SAMPLE STATEMENTS AND INVOICES. Some additional information may be found in the OUTOING CORRESPONDENCE and INCOMING CORRESPONDENCE series. The records include incorporation documents, memoranda, directors' minutes, reports and financial statements, account books, legal documents, and lists of mill assets, prices, shipping and equipment stored. Arranged by type of record.

TRAPPERS' MEETING MINUTES (1961). 5 mm. Box 20.

Those in attendance at the meeting included 48 trappers, Porritt, and federal game officers.

HUNTING LICENCE LISTS (1961-1977). 5 mm. Box 20.

There are gaps in this series from 1965-1966, and 1971-1974. The lists are for general hunting licences issued in Hay River and general hunting licences for Wood Buffalo Park. The lists provide the name, licence number, and community of the hunter. Arrangement is chronological.

FUR AUCTION CONSIGNMENT STATEMENTS (1950-1983). 9 cm. Box 20.

Statements, invoices, delivery and packing slips from Edmonton Fur Auction Sales Ltd., Little Bros. Fur Sales Agency Ltd., Canadian Fur Auction Sales Co., Western Canadian Raw Fur Auction Sales Ltd. and Hudson's Bay Company are represented in this series. The records provide information on the quantities and the prices of furs Forritt traded. Arranged by company.

FUR DEALER RECORD/FUR TRADER RECORD (1969-1983). 4 cm. Box 20 and matted oversize items shelved on oversized boxes 28 to 30.

The records are dated 1969, 1977-1979 and 1983. Fur traders were apparently required to complete the forms for government. They provide trappers' names, licence numbers, type and quantities of furs and their price. Unarranged.

SAMPLE CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS FILES (1949-1966). 8 cm. Box 21.

These are samples of customer accounts for May River Supplies. The files provide examples of the types of records Porritt kept for the store, and how they were used. For individual sales Porritt wrote up 'counter sales cheques' (c.s. on his statements). He issued statements periodically (monthly?) listing the counter sales cheques balances outstanding, by date and number, and any payments. Porritt retained copies of the counter sales cheques and statements and used these to complete his ledgers and journals. Each sample account file has a portion of the records for a single customer, either an individual or company. The series contains sales cheques matched to their corresponding statements, company order books and purchase orders, and ledger or journal pages. files are an example of the records Forritt would keep filed in an envelope labelled with a customer's name. Some, though perhaps not all, of the accounting pages within an envelope had been removed directly from the journals and ledgers, although the reason for doing this is not clear. Only a portion of the accounting records were recovered with any sort of original arrangement. Arranged alphabetically by customer names.

CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS (1944-1979). 52 cm. Boxes 21 to 23 and oversize box 29. These records have been divided into subseries: 'Statements', 'Ledger and Journal Sheets', and 'Fur Trade Accounts'. The records of Hay River Supplies and Porritt's fur trading were, for the most part, interfiled as the trappers Porritt traded with were also customers of his store. Goods could be taken on credit and later paid for with furs. Porritt used the same types of documents, counter sales cheques and ledger/journal sheets to record his fur trade transactions. For these reasons, the subseries 'Fur Trade Accounts' also contains records relating to Hay River Supplies, and the subseries 'Statements' and 'Ledger and Journal Sheets' may also have references to fur trading. Later records, from about 1966 on, appear to be mostly relating to the fur trade, and it may be that Hay River Supplies was no longer operating at that time. Unarranged.

RECORDS PERTAINING TO OTHER BUSINESSES (1946-1967). 3 cm. Box 23.

Robert Porritt was involved in a number of other business activities in addition to Fort Resolution Lumber Co., Hay River Supplies, and fur trading. During the late 1940s he operated a barge business called Robert Porritt Transportaion, and while running Hay River Supplies he also rented out rooms and cabins, possibly as the manager of the Hay River Hotel. He had been involved in construction supervision, operated as purchasing agent, and may have had some involvement with Hay River Truck Lines Ltd. This series provides some documentation on these and other of Porritt's business activities. Unarranged.

CANADIAN AIRWAYS RECORDS (1932-1941). 5 cm. Box 23 and oversize box 28. The majority of these records are dated 1939-1941 and relate to Robert Porritt's employment as an agent with Canadian Airways. The series consists of documents such as Agency Balance Sheets, Report of Ticket Sales, Agency Outstandings, and Abstracts of Way Bills Forwarded. In addition, there are oversized sheets from 1940-1941 that record details of each transaction, listing goods transported, way bill number, date, weight, charges and consignee. The records also include a 1938 Service Agents' Agreement between Porritt and the company, and what may be the company's codebook. Unarranged.

MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL RECORDS (Cca. 1954-19671). 33 cm. Boxes 23 to 24.

These records were created during Forritt's terms as member of the Legislative Council for Mackenzie South from 1954-1960, and 1963-1967. Records generated by Porritt include copies of his motions to council, annotated documents, transcripts of his speeches in Council, travel expense records, and 5 cm. of unsorted typed material which seems to consist of speeches, presentations or reports to council, "Northern Notes", and miscellaneous. Issues of concern to Porritt include railway routes, roads and bridges, treatment of native people, employment, fisheries, local industry, hunting and trapping regulations and liquor regulations. The records also contain material Forritt received as a Member of Council: Council Minutes (1956). Precis of Council Proceedings (1964). Resolutions and Actions of Council, Council Reports, Tuesday Letters from Commissioner Ben G. Sivertz (1964-1967), copies of correspondence addressed to the commissioner or Council, copies of motions, information relating to council travel in the communities, press reports covering council, petitions and briefs to Council, memoribilia and ephemera. Briefs to Council (12 cm.) cover topics such as workmen's compensation, fisheries, game laws, location of the Nortwest Territories capital, archives and library, poor drinking water quality in Hay River, radio broadcasting, fisheries, transportation routes and road conditions

and recreational facilities. For handwritten notes or drafts concerning Council, see the HANDWRITTEN NOTES series. For council correspondence copied to Porritt, see the INCOMING CORRESPONDENCE series. Arranged by type of record.

ELECTION RECORDS (Cca. 1945-19701). 9 cm. Boxes 24 to 25, oversize box 29. These records document elections involving Porritt from 1945-1970. They include official documents such as Rural List of Electors (1949), Rural Preliminary Lists of Electors (1951-1972), Municipal Voters Lists for Hay River (1959-1979), statements of votes and of the polls, certificates of voting, tally sheets, lists of Deputy Returning Officers, and nomination papers. Most of the records originate in Hay River or elsewhere in his Mackenzie South riding, but there are also several documents from Yellowknife from the mid-1940s. For Porritt's election speeches, see the series MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL RECORDS, typed notes and speeches; for notes and lists relating to elections, see the HANDWRITTEN NOTES series. Arranged by type of record; voter's lists are arranged by polling station and chronologically.

PERSONAL MEMORABILIA (1946-1983). 1 cm. Box 25.

This series consists of Porritt's personal identification, awards, certificates and invitations. Included is his 1946 National Registration identity card, an announcement of his receiving the centennial medal and an invitation to meet the Queen and Prince Philip in 1959. Also included are several versions of Porritt's personally designed Christmas cards, "From the Scrapbook of Bobby Porrit" (which include photograph images, information on Porritt, and northern people and events). Unarranged.

ADDITIONAL MEMORABILIA (Cca. 1920-1980). 10 cm. Box 25 and oversize box 30 deacessoned. These records consist of Porritt's postcard collection (only those representing the Northwest Territories have been retained), and Northwest Territories related placemats and calendars. The calendars, dated between 1952 and 1974, are mainly from Hay River businesses and include two from Hay River Supplies.
