The tourism program for the Government of the Northwest Territories operated under the Tourism Promotion Section of the Department of Economic Development. From 1977, TravelArctic, a division of the Department of Economic Development and Tourism has handled these matters.

This accession consists of 18 cm. of textual material produced by the GNWT and other sources concerned with promoting travel in the Northwest Territories including the federal government, outfitters, tour operators and lodges. Included among the files is information concerning the development of a tourism strategy for the Northwest Territories, pamphlets outlining fishing and hunting regulations, reports on Commissioners' tours, general information on the communities and attractions in the Northwest Territories.
