

Members of Council were asked to consider and give first and second readings to an amendment to Sub-section 2 of Section 67 of the Game Ordinance whereby the issue of licences to take marten would be restricted to heads of households, under suitable bag limits.

Present regulations provide that holders of general hunting licences may obtain licences to take marten, under bag limits set up for each of three areas. Urgent representations have now been received from our field officers to the effect that the issue of marten licences to those who are not heads of households would result in too heavy a drain on the marten population.

Council concurred in the draft amendment and gave it first and second readings.

CHAPTER 33

An Ordinance to amend an Ordinance Respecting the
Preservation of Game in the Northwest Territories

(Assented to December 9, 1949)

The Commissioner of the Northwest Territories
by and with the advice and consent of the Council of the said
Territories enacts as follows:

1. Subsection two of section sixty-seven of the
Game Ordinance, chapter twelve of the Ordinances of 1949, as
enacted by chapter twenty-seven of the said Ordinances is repealed
and the following substituted therefor:-

"(2) A licence may be issued to the holder of a
general hunting licence who is the head of a house-
hold authorizing him to take,

(a) not more than twenty-five marten in the
basin of the Anderson River;

(b) not more than ten marten in that part of
the area described in Schedule "G" which
is North of the sixty-third parallel of
North Latitude and not in the basin of
the Anderson River, or

(c) not more than five marten in that part of
the area described in Schedule "G" which
is South of the sixty-third parallel of
North Latitude.

(3) For the purposes of subsection two the "head of
a household" means a person who is the sole support
of one or more dependents."
